A Message from our Pastor:

Dear Parishioners,

By now you should have received your new parish envelopes from Our Sunday Visitor. If you have not received them, please contact the parish office so we can make sure we have your correct information.

The one important difference you will notice is that we now have a monthly envelope labeled Building Fund, which is replacing the weekly red bordered Preservation Fund envelopes. This fund is designated for preserving our buildings and grounds through ongoing improvement and maintenance projects. The reason for having this as a monthly envelope instead of weekly is simply to save money on the cost of our envelopes. Adding another weekly envelope would out us into a higher tier pricing range for providing our envelopes, which is something we wanted to avoid. I hope you will recognize the importance of continuing to give to this parish fund and recognize the value of the good that continues to be done with it. As I mentioned not long ago, some of our next projects are the exterior facade of the church and signage, the replacement of the roof of the large storage building, a.k.a. the hangar, as well as the

parking lot paving. As always, your generous support of your parish is much appreciated and never taken for granted. Buildings are not our mission, but they allow us to carry out that mission and so they are important to properly maintain and keep up. God bless you for all you do that makes St. Nicholas a great parish.
