A Message from our Pastor:


Dear Parishioners,

Our first dates for photos for the parish picture directory are this week. It looks like there are still plenty of open spots available. Please schedule your day and time as soon as possible. The new directory will be a very nice addition to our upcoming 50th Anniversary Year, which begins this November. More on that in next weeks bulletin. For your photos, this is a great opportunity to get family members together for your own personal family portraits. Simply go online and sign up today. If you need assistance scheduling a time, please give us a call and we can help you with that.

I have noticed we have not had any altar flowers recently. I want to remind you that you can order flowers during Ordinary Time for our Blessed Mother or St. Joseph Shrines by calling the parish office. During the seasons of Advent, Christmas and Easter, we take care of that from our flower collections (in Lent flowers are not permitted, save for the feasts of St. Joseph and the Annunciation). So, during Ordinary Time you may offer flowers in memory of a loved one and we will publish the name(s) in the bulletin. Ordinary Time is the liturgical time in between the seasons mentioned, most easily noticed by the use of the liturgical color of green.

Looking ahead a little to August, the 27th is the feast of St. Monica. She is the mother of St. Augustine, who famously prayed and wept, and no doubt fasted too, for about 17 years for her son Augustine's conversion. She also

prayed for many years for her husband and mother-in-law to be converted. She is a great example of patient suffering and prayer for the conversion of a loved one. St. Monica has become a source of hope and inspiration for all those who mourn the lack of faith in a loved one and pray for a conversion. I have long wanted to begin to offer Mass each year on or near her feast day for this intention and I think the Lord is telling me to do this now. This year, St. Monica's feast day falls on a Sunday, so it is not observed in the liturgy, so we will have Mass the next day, which is the feast of her son, St. Augustine, for the intention of the conversion of our loved ones back to the regular practice of the faith. The Mass will be at 7PM, Monday August 28, and I invite you to come and we will offer this Mass for anyone and everyone you know and love who is no longer (or never did) practice the faith. My hope is to make this an annual event on or near St. Monica's feat day. Like St. Monica we must never despair of the possibility of conversion. Our prayers will water the seed of faith that may be lying dormant, but that is surely still present and by grace able to spring to life again.
