A Message from our Pastor:

Dear Parishioners.

We know that as Catholics we are obligated to attend the Holy Mass every Sunday and Holy Day of Obligation. It is helpful for us to understand that this obligation comes from the need for us, as creatures, to give to God, the creator, what we, in justice owe to Him. The most interesting thing about this is that God needs nothing from us. So why are we obliged to give Him what He does not need? We must not forget that the nature of God is pure love. This love that is God is always giving. When we give to Him what is His due, it is actually fulfilling a need in us. It is so important a need, that it is an obligation of the gravest seriousness. When we do not fulfill this obligation, it harms us, not just a little, but in a serious way. It is a mortal wound upon the soul. And when we fulfill this obligation we are strengthened, we become more and more fully alive. What exactly is the nature of this obligation to God? It is fourfold, we owe Him adoration, thanksgiving, satisfaction (or atonement) and petition. Over the next few weeks we will take a closer look at each of these and how each of them is fulfilled perfectly in the Holy Mass. This happens not because of an act of man, but of God. The Mass is His gift to us. In it He gives us the perfect way to fulfill our obligation to Him and in so doing to build up our own life, or rather, to allow the Divine Life for which we have been created to be built up in us. August 15 is the Holy Day of Mary's Assumption and August 22 is the feast of Mary's queenship. These days just offer an opportunity to pray a beautiful Novena to Our Blessed Mother, Queen of Heaven. A prayer is printed below for you to use each day beginning tomorrow.

Novena to Our Blessed Mother Mary, Queen of Heaven

I greet you, ever-blessed Virgin, Mother of God, refuge of sinners, and Queen of the Universe.

Most loving Mother, attracted by your beauty, sweetness, and tender compassion, I confidently turn to you, and beg of you to obtain for me of your dear Son the favor I request in this novena: (mention your request).

Obtain for me also, Queen of Heaven and Earth, the most lively contrition for my many sins and the grace to imitate closely those virtues which you practiced so faithfully, especially humility, purity, and obedience. Above all, I beg you to be my mother and protectress, to receive me into the number of your devoted children, and to guide me from your high throne of glory. Do not reject my petitions, Mother of Mercy! Have pity on me, and do not abandon me during life or at the moment of my death.

Accept this offering, sweet Queen of Heaven and Earth, and obtain for me from your dear Son, Jesus Christ, the favors I ask through your intercession in this novena. Obtain for me also a generous, constant love of God, perfect submission to His Holy Will, the true spirit of a Christian, and the grace of final perseverance.
