A Message from our Pastor:

Dear Parishioners,

We continue our current series of reflections, this week looking at the Mass as Thanksgiving. It should not be hard to see that if we owe God our adoration, we must also owe Him our gratitude, our thanksgiving, for He not only created us and all that is, but also keeps us and all things existing. This existence would be of little value had He not also redeemed us and therefore gives us a life that will not end and the means for that life to be one of perfect joy and fulfillment. How could we ever thank Him enough, or show enough gratitude to Him. Once again, God Himself provides us the way. In the prayers of the The Holy Mass we give thanks to God in word and also in action, for the Holy Mass is an act of thanksgiving to God. The word Eucharist means thanksgiving. Our Catechism teaches us that: The Eucharist is a sacrifice of thanksgiving to the Father, a blessing by which the Church expresses her gratitude to God for all his benefits, for all that he has accomplished through creation, redemption, and sanctification. Eucharist means first of all "thanksgiving." (CCC 1360)

How are we thanking God in the celebration of the Holy Mass? By offering to Him the perfect sacrifice of His Son, of His Body and Blood, which is made present again, truly present, under the forms of bread and wine. In the Holy Eucharist is summed up every good thing God has done for us, for all of His works are contained in the presence of His Son made flesh, of the Divine Word Incarnate. The Son is the Word by whom all things are created, so all of the gifts of creation are summed up in Him. He is the Word made flesh - come to be our redeemer, so the gift of redemption is found in Him. He is the way that leads to the Father, and He is the One into whose Body we are incorporated so as to

be joined to God, so all the gifts of sanctification are also represented in Him. In offering the Holy Eucharist to the Father we are offering the gift of creation, redemption and sanctification as an act of perfect praise and thanksgiving for these gifts. There is no greater way to thanks God than by participating in the Holy Mass.
